Church Mission Elements (MEs)

A regular section of survey rates church on eight mission elements.

Key Take Aways:

- Year on year (2016 versus 2015), the results were stable / slightly improve. Of these ME #4-6 have the worst scores. Some notable changes:
 - ME #6 increased 5% (ME #5 is "a sustainable church community in which [church] share stewardship of both our tangible and our human resources.".) This is likely due to implementation of JBAH and completion of a union contract.
 - ME #4 (transparancy) is still the poorest but improved 4% over 2015—still below prior years, however.

For comparison, the Table below shows data going back to 2012 –pulled from the Sept 22, 2015 ET Monitoring Report.




Q1 Which church programs and activities that you currently participate in regularly are most important to you? Please check all that apply.





Q2 Which church programs and activities would you most like to see added or substantially improved? Please identify the top 1-3 that are most important to you (1= most important).




Q12 What is your age?







Q13 How long have you been attending services or participating in programs at First Unitarian?





Q14 Since the start of this Church year (September 2015), how often have you attend Sunday services in person?





Q15 Since the start of this church year (September 2015), how often have you watched a service via live stream (or a live-stream replay), read a sermon reprint, or listened to a church podcast?





Q16 Are you a member of the First Unitarian Church of Portland?






Q18 If you have children or youth in your household, how many currently participate in RE on Sundays or other programs for children and youth?


