



# Q2 Which of the following offerings are you most drawn to help you deepen your spirituality and build community? Please check no more than three.







#### Q4 Which kind of Church experience do you value most? Please check no more than two.




# Q5 What are the barriers to your participation in programs, events, and classes? Check all that apply.









# Q10 Overall, how would you rate the "energy" or health of the Church community this year?








# Q13 How long have you been attending services or participating in programs at First Unitarian?



### Q14 Since the start of this Church year (September 2017), how often have you attended Sunday services in person?










#### Q16 Are you a member of the First Unitarian Church of Portland?






