Unitarian Universalists for Justice in the Middle East Siding with love with the people of Palestine-Israel

For many years I have been concerned that the social justice concerns of UUs have been largely limited to domestic issues. These issues are of great importance but so are issues outside our borders such as war and peace and the US drive for hegemony. Over half of the discretionary budget that we pay for with our taxes goes for war leaving relatively little for social goods here at home.

Recently, however, and particularly since the Hamas attack of October 7, 2023, the UUA and many UU organizations have spoken out against the near genocidal war that Israel has waged against the people of Gaza. Below is a list of these actions that different UU groups have taken.

Recent Actions by Unitarian Universalists in support of Palestinian human rights.

In May of 2021, the UUSC declared that all military aid to Israel must stop until the rights of Palestinians are respected and International Law is obeyed. <u>https://www.uusc.org/uusc-calls-on-the-u-s-government-to-withhold-military-aid-to-israel/</u>

In October of 2023, a group of Unitarian Universalist religious professionals and lay leaders (as yet the group is unnamed) published an "Open Letter on the War and Occupation in Palestine". More than 100 UUs and three UU organizations have signed, including Diverse Revolutionary Unitarian Universalist Multicultural Ministries (DRUUMM), UUs for Justice in the Middle East, and the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee. The letter called for a ceasefire, an end to US military aid to Israel, an end to the occupation and necessary conversations about the impacts of Zionism.
