What appeals to you most about the UUA's revised Article II and the process that has shaped it over the past few years?

Article II Proposed Revision

- Incorporates and builds on all current 7 principles.
- Includes love at the center
- Adds emphasis on collective action, working together
- Includes one-sentence statements of covenants with each value that describe ways we can act on those values
- Value and covenant statements are action-oriented and eloquent
- Integrates the 8th principle into many of the values and covenants.
- Emphasizes the importance of inclusion and radical welcoming
- Speaks directly to justice and social justice principles and purposes
- Graphic, visual presentation is a powerful way to illustrate that our values are centered on and flow out from love
- Content likely to appeal to younger members and friends.
- Good to explicitly state that we are accountable to one another for working together to live our shared values.

Process of Shaping Article II Revision

- National process was very inclusive, including young people as well as those with diverse racial and cultural backgrounds
- Has built on on groundswell of support for the 8th principle in our denomination and among many congregations.
- We have more to learn, and this meeting has been very useful.
- Our discussion process in this meeting was good.

What concerns you most about the revised Article II and the upcoming process for considering its adoption at the UUA's 2024 General Assembly?

Revised Article II

- Revised values and covenant are wordy and complicated, not as simple and clear as 7 principles.
- May need to develop a shorter (two or three sentence) summary statement that covers all 6 values & covenants.

- Incorporating 8th principle language into values and covenants may not be acceptable to some congregations too much focus on anti-racism.
- Democracy is included within the Justice value rather than standing alone as it does in 7 principles.
- Some feel that Love at the center is a proxy for God, which may not sit will with atheists, agnostics or humanists in our denomination.
- It's not clear what "Beloved Community" may mean to people outside our denomination?

<u>Upcoming Processes for Considering Adoption of Revised Article II</u>

- Need to come to a shared understanding of terms like "covenant" and "accountable" through further discussion meetings like this.
- Need more conversations about the 8th principle to increase understanding of why and how it's been woven into the proposed revision of Article II.
- Disappointed that a children's version of the revision has not been developed concurrently with the adult version - UUA will need to pay attention to this ASAP if revision is adopted.
- Should be sure to involve newcomers and young people in our congregation's processes of preparing for GA 2024 and implementing revised Article II if it's adopted.
- Our GA 2024 delegates should participate in additional preparatory meetings prior to the June GA.
- Need to allocate additional denominational and congregational resources to educating members and friends about Article II, especially if this revision is adopted by delegates to 2024 GA.
